- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. TRANSFER OF FUNDS.
- 4 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any provision of
- 5 the Department of Defense Appropriations Act, 1996
- 6 (Public Law 104–61), the Secretary of Defense shall
- 7 transfer \$6,500,000,000 of unobligated funds appro-
- 8 priated under such Act for fiscal year 1996 to the Violent
- 9 Crime Reduction Trust Fund established under section

- 1 310001 of the Violent Crime Control and Law Enforce-
- 2 ment Act of 1994 (42 U.S.C. 14211).
- 3 (b) Allocation.—The Secretary of Defense shall al-
- 4 locate the amount transferred under subsection (a) from
- 5 among any programs in the Department of Defense for
- 6 which funding was not requested in the 1996 budget re-
- 7 quest of the President.
- 8 SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR COMMUNITY-ORIENTED POLICING
- 9 **PROGRAMS**.
- The amount transferred under section 1 shall only
- 11 be used for community-oriented policing programs under
- 12 section 1701(b) of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe
- 13 Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796dd(b)).
