AN ACT

To prohibit the imposition of access charges on Internet service providers, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Internet Access Charge3 Prohibition Act of 2000".

4 SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF CHARGES ON PROVIDERS OF 5 INTERNET ACCESS SERVICE.

6 Section 254 of the Communications Act of 1934 (47
7 U.S.C. 254) is amended by adding at the end the following
8 new subsection:

9 "(1) PROHIBITION OF CHARGES ON INTERNET SERV10 ICE PROVIDERS.—

11 "(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsection 12 (b)(4) or (d) or any other provision of this title, the 13 Commission shall not impose on any provider of 14 Internet access service (as such term is defined in 15 section 231(e)) any contribution for the support of universal service that is based on a measure of the 16 17 time that telecommunications services are used in 18 the provision of such Internet access service.

19 "(2) RULE OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in
20 this subsection shall preclude the Commission from
21 imposing access charges on the providers of Internet
22 telephone services, irrespective of the type of cus-

 such services.".
