AN ACT

Entitled "The Cochran-Inouye National Missile Defense Act of 1999".

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "National Missile De-
- 5 fense Act of 1999".

SEC. 2. NATIONAL MISSILE DEFENSE POLICY.

- 2 It is the policy of the United States to deploy as soon
- 3 as is technologically possible an effective National Missile
- 4 Defense system capable of defending the territory of the
- 5 United States against limited ballistic missile attack
- 6 (whether accidental, unauthorized, or deliberate) with
- 7 funding subject to the annual authorization of appropria-
- 8 tions and the annual appropriation of funds for National
- 9 Missile Defense.
- 10 SEC. 3. POLICY ON REDUCTION OF RUSSIAN NUCLEAR
- 11 FORCES.
- 12 It is the policy of the United States to seek continued
- 13 negotiated reductions in Russian nuclear forces.
