A BILL

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Secure Access to Fire-

5 arms Enhancement (SAFE) Act of 2003".

1SEC. 2. RECIPROCITY FOR THE CARRYING OF CERTAIN2CONCEALED FIREARMS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 44 of title 18, United
4 States Code, is amended by inserting after section 926A
5 the following:

6 "§926B. Reciprocity for the carrying of certain con7 cealed firearms

8 "Notwithstanding any provision of the law of any
9 State or political subdivision thereof, a person who is not
10 prohibited by Federal law from possessing, transporting,
11 shipping, or receiving a firearm, and is—

12 "(1) carrying a valid license or permit which is 13 issued pursuant to the law of any State and which 14 permits the person to carry a concealed firearm; or 15 "(2) otherwise entitled to carry a concealed fire-16 arm in and pursuant to the law of the State of the 17 person's residence,

18 may carry in any State a concealed firearm in accordance
19 with the terms of the license or with the laws of the State
20 of the person's residence, subject to the laws of the State
21 in which the firearm is carried concerning specific types
22 of locations in which firearms may not be carried.".

(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
for chapter 44 of title 18 is amended by inserting after
the item relating to section 926A the following:

"926B. Reciprocity for the carrying of certain concealed firearms.".

1 SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.

2 The provisions of this Act and the amendments made3 by this Act shall take effect 180 days after the date of4 enactment of this Act.
