3 thirds of each House concurring therein), That the fol-4 lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-5 stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all 6 intents and purposes as part of the Constitution when 7 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several 8 States within seven years after the date of its submission 9 for ratification: 2
