Mr. DREIER, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4759) to implement the United States-Australia Free Trade Agreement.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order without intervention of any point of
3 order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 4759) to
4 implement the United States-Australia Free Trade Agree-
5 ment. The bill shall be considered as read for amendment.
6 The bill shall be debatable for two hours equally divided
7 and controlled by the chairman and ranking minority
8 member of the Committee on Ways and Means. Pursuant

1 to section 151(f)(2) of the Trade Act of 1974, the previous
2 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final
3 passage without intervening motion.

4 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 4759 pursuant
5 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
6 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-
7 eration of the bill to a time designated by the Speaker.
