## A BILL

To repeal the sunset date on the assault weapons ban, to ban the importation of large capacity ammunition feeding devices, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Assault Weapons Ban  
5 Reauthorization Act of 2003”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF SUNSET DATE.**

7 Section 110105 of the Public Safety and Recreational  
8 Firearms Use Protection Act (18 U.S.C. 921 note) is  
9 amended to read as follows:

1 **“SEC. 110105. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2 “This subtitle and the amendments made by this sub-  
3 title shall take effect on September 13, 1994.”.

4 **SEC. 3. BAN ON IMPORTING LARGE CAPACITY AMMUNI-  
5 TION FEEDING DEVICES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 922(w) of title 18, United  
7 States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(1) Except as  
9 provided in paragraph (2)” and inserting “(1)(A)  
10 Except as provided in subparagraph (B)”;

11 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking “(2) Para-  
12 graph (1)” and inserting “(B) Subparagraph (A)”;

13 (3) by inserting before paragraph (3) the fol-  
14 lowing:

15 “(2) It shall be unlawful for any person to import  
16 a large capacity ammunition feeding device.”; and

17 (4) in paragraph (4)—

18 (A) by striking “(1)” each place it appears  
19 and inserting “(1)(A)”;

20 (B) by striking “(2)” and inserting  
21 “(1)(B)”.

22 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 921(a)(31)  
23 of title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking  
24 “manufactured after the date of enactment of the Violent  
25 Crime Control and Law Enforcement Act of 1994”.
