1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DISCHARGE IN BANKRUPTCY FOR CERTAIN**
4 **EDUCATIONAL LOANS.**

5 Section 523(a)(8) of title 11, United States Code, is
6 amended by striking “dependents, for” and all that follows
7 through subparagraph (B) and inserting “dependents, for
8 an educational benefit overpayment or loan made, insured,
9 or guaranteed by a governmental unit, or an obligation

- 1 to repay funds received from a governmental unit as an
- 2 educational benefit, scholarship, or stipend.”.
