# A BILL

To waive the non-Federal share of the cost of certain disaster assistance provided in connection with Hurricanes Katrina and Rita, and for other purposes. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Hurricanes Katrina5 and Rita Federal Match Relief Act of 2007".

### 6 SEC. 2. FEDERAL SHARE OF DISASTER ASSISTANCE.

7 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, including 8 any agreement, the Federal share of the cost of disaster 9 assistance provided before the date of enactment of this 10 Act in connection with Hurricane Katrina or Rita under title IV of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and 11 Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5170 et seq.), in-12 13 cluding direct Federal assistance, shall be 100 percent with respect to assistance provided for the States of Lou-14 15 isiana and Mississippi.

### 16 SEC. 3. CANCELLATION OF LOANS.

(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 2(a) of the Community
18 Disaster Loan Act of 2005 (Public Law 109–88) is
19 amended by striking "*Provided further*, That notwith20 standing section 417(c)(1) of the Stafford Act, such loans
21 may not be canceled:".

(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made bythis section shall be effective on the date of enactment of

- 1 the Community Disaster Loan Act of 2005 (Public Law
- 2 109-88).
