3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Domestic Violence Vic-

1	SEC. 2. ENCOURAGEMENT OF GUN CONFISCATION POLI-
2	CIES IN DOMESTIC VIOLENCE CASES.

6	(1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph

9	graph (5)(B) and inserting "; and"; and
10	(3) by adding at the end the following new
11	paragraph:

13	"(A) provide that a law enforcement officer
14	who has probable cause that an act of domestic
15	violence has been committed may—
16	"(i) question persons present to deter-
17	mine whether there are weapons on the

10	SEC. 3. ELIMINATION OF SPECIFIC INTENT TO CAUSE FEAR
11	FROM THE ELEMENTS OF THE OFFENSE OF

13	Section 40602 of the Violence Against Women Act
14	of 1994 (42 U.S.C. 14031) is amended by adding at the
15	end the following new subsection:
16	"(c) Elements of Stalking Offense.—To be eli-
17	gible to receive a grant under subsection (a), a State or

18 SONNEL FOR ENTERING PROTECTION OR-19 DERS.

(a) GRANTS TO ENCOURAGE ARREST POLICIES.—
21 Paragraph (12) of section 2101(b) of the Omnibus Crime
22 Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C.
23 3796hh(b)(12)) is amended by inserting ", and to hire and
24 maintain additional personnel for entering information re25 lating to protection orders" before the period.

(b) GRANTS RELATING TO STALKING AND DOMESTIC
 VIOLENCE.—Section 40602 of the Violence Against
 Women Act of 1994 (42 U.S.C. 14031) is amended by
 striking the period at the end of subsection (a) and insert ing the following: ", which may include hiring and main taining additional personnel for entering such data.".
