 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Right to Clean Vehicles3 Act".

4 SEC. 2. WAIVER OF PREEMPTION FOR CALIFORNIA GREEN5 HOUSE GAS EMISSION REGULATION FOR VE6 HICLES.

7 Section 209 of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7543)8 is amended by adding at the end the following:

9 "(f) WAIVER.—Notwithstanding subsection (b) or 10 any other provision of law, the application for a waiver 11 of preemption dated December 21, 2005, submitted to the 12 Administrator pursuant to subsection (b) by the State of 13 California for the regulation of that State to control green-14 house gas emissions from motor vehicles shall be consid-15 ered to be approved.".
