- 5 Section 302(g) of the Clean Air Act (42 U.S.C.
- 6 7602(g)) is amended by adding the following at the end
- 7 thereof: "The term 'air pollutant' shall not include carbon
- 8 dioxide, water vapor, methane, or chloroflourocarbons.".
