- 4 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS RELATING TO

- 6 (a) Disclosure of Disbursements for Commu-
- 7 NICATIONS.—Section 304(f) of the Federal Election Cam-
- 8 paign Act of 1971 (2 U.S.C. 434(f)) is amended by adding
- 9 at the end the following new paragraph:
- 10 "(8) Termination of Reporting Require-
- 11 MENT.—No person shall be required to file any
- statement under this subsection with respect to any
- disbursement made on or after November 6, 2002.".

- 25 (2) by redesignating subparagraph (D) as sub-
- paragraph (C).
