RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2102) to maintain the free flow of information to the public by providing conditions for the federally compelled disclosure of information by certain persons connected with the news media.

- 1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
- 2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
- 3 2102) to maintain the free flow of information to the pub-
- 4 lic by providing conditions for the federally compelled dis-
- 5 closure of information by certain persons connected with

1 the news media. All points of order against consideration
2 of the bill are waived except those arising under clause
3 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The amendment in the nature of
4 a substitute recommended by the Committee on the Judi-
5 ciary now printed in the bill shall be considered as adopt-
6 ed. The bill, as amended, shall be considered as read. All
7 points of order against provisions of the bill, as amended,
8 are waived. The previous question shall be considered as
9 ordered on the bill, as amended, to final passage without
10 intervening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally
11 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
12 nority member of the Committee on the Judiciary; (2) the
13 amendment printed in the report of the Committee on
14 Rules, if offered by Representative Boucher of Virginia or
15 his designee, which shall be in order without intervention
16 of any point of order (except those arising under clause
17 9 or 10 of rule XXI) or demand for division of the ques-
18 tion, shall be considered as read, and shall be separately
19 debatable for ten minutes equally divided and controlled
20 by the proponent and an opponent; and (3) one motion
21 to recommit with or without instructions.

22 SEC. 2. During consideration of H.R. 2102 pursuant
23 to this resolution, notwithstanding the operation of the
24 previous question, the Chair may postpone further consid-

- 1 eration of the bill to such time as may be designated by
- 2 the Speaker.
