7	(1) by redesignating subclause (IV) as sub-
8	clause (VI); and
9	(2) by inserting after subclause (III) the fol-
10	lowing new subclauses:
11	"(IV) An entity that is operated
12	by a health center of an institution of
13	higher education, the primary purpose
14	of which is to provide health services
15	to students of that institution.
16	"(V) An entity that is a public or
17	private nonprofit entity that provides
18	a service or services described under
19	section 1001(a) of the Public Health
