## A BILL

To require a study and report on the feasibility and potential of establishing a deep water sea port in the Arctic to protect and advance strategic United States interests within the evolving and ever more important region.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Arctic Deep Water
- 5 Sea Port Act of 2010".
- 6 SEC. 2. REPORT ON ESTABLISHMENT OF ARCTIC DEEP
- 7 **WATER PORT.**
- 8 (a) STUDY.—

1	(1) In General.—The Secretary of Defense, in
2	consultation with the Secretary of Homeland Secu-
3	rity, shall conduct a study on the feasibility and po-
4	tential of establishing a deep water sea port in the
5	Arctic to protect and advance strategic United
6	States interests within the evolving and ever more
7	important Arctic region.
8	(2) Scope.—The study required under para-
9	graph (1) shall address the following issues:
10	(A) The capability that such a port would
11	provide.
12	(B) Potential and optimum locations for
13	such a port.
14	(C) Resources needed to establish such a
15	port.
16	(D) The time frame needed to establish
17	such a port.
18	(E) The infrastructure required to support
19	such a port, including Command, Control, Com-
20	munications, Computers, Intelligence, Surveil-
21	lance and Reconnaissance (C4ISR) facilities,
22	health care facilities, barracks and housing, air-
23	field and pier support, and operations facilities.
24	(F) Any other issues the Secretary deter-
25	mines necessary to complete the study.

- 1 (b) Report.—Not later than two years after the date
- 2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Defense
- 3 shall submit to the Committees on Armed Services and
- 4 Appropriations of the Senate and the House of Represent-
- 5 atives a report on the findings of the study conducted

6 under subsection (a).
