## A BILL

1 **SECTION 1. APPOINTMENTS TO MILITARY SERVICE ACAD-**  
2 **EMIES FROM NOMINATIONS MADE BY DELE-**  
3 **GATES FROM THE COMMONWEALTH OF THE**  
4 **NORTHERN MARIANA ISLANDS AND AMER-**  
5 **ICAN SAMOA.**

6 (a) UNITED STATES MILITARY ACADEMY.—Section  
7 4342(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (9), by striking “Two” and in-  
9 serting “Three”; and

10 (2) in paragraph (10), by striking “One” and  
11 inserting “Three”.

12 (b) UNITED STATES NAVAL ACADEMY.—Section  
13 6954(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

14 (1) in paragraph (9), by striking “Two” and in-  
15 serting “Three”; and

16 (2) in paragraph (10), by striking “One” and  
17 inserting “Three”.

18 (c) UNITED STATES AIR FORCE ACADEMY.—Section  
19 9342(a) of title 10, United States Code, is amended—

20 (1) In paragraph (9), by striking “Two” and  
21 inserting “Three”; and

22 (2) in paragraph (10), by striking “One” and  
23 inserting “Three”.

24 (d) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by  
25 this section shall apply with respect to the nomination of  
26 candidates for appointment to the United States Military

1 Academy, the United States Naval Academy, and the  
2 United States Air Force Academy for classes entering  
3 these military service academies after the date of the en-  
4 actment of this Act.
