AN ACT

- To provide for a land exchange involving certain National Forest System lands in the Mendocino National Forest in the State of California, and for other purposes.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Deafy Glade Land Ex-
- 3 change Act''.
- 4 SEC. 2. LAND EXCHANGE, MENDOCINO NATIONAL FOREST,
- 5 CALIFORNIA.
- 6 (a) Land Exchange Required.—If Solano County,
- 7 California (in this section referred to as the "County")
- 8 conveys to the Secretary of Agriculture all right, title, and
- 9 interest of the County in and to four parcels of land con-
- 10 sisting of a total of approximately 160 acres identified on
- 11 the map entitled "Fouts Springs-Deafy Glade Federal and
- 12 Non-Federal Lands" and dated July 17, 2008, the Sec-
- 13 retary shall convey to the County, in exchange, all right,
- 14 title, and interest of the United States in and to the parcel
- 15 of land in the Mendocino National Forest in the State of
- 16 California (including any improvements on the land) com-
- 17 prising approximately 82 acres and known as the Fouts
- 18 Springs Ranch, as also depicted on the map.
- 19 (b) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map referred to in
- 20 subsection (a) shall be on file and available for public in-
- 21 spection in the Office of the Chief of the Forest Service.
- 22 With the agreement of the County, the Secretary may
- 23 make technical corrections to the map and the legal de-
- 24 scriptions of the land to be exchanged under this section.
- 25 (c) Land Exchange Process.—Section 206 of the
- 26 Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43)

- 1 U.S.C. 1716) shall apply to the land exchange under this
- 2 section.
- 3 (d) Survey and Administrative Costs.—The
- 4 exact acreage and legal description of the land to be ex-
- 5 changed under subsection (a) shall be determined by a
- 6 survey satisfactory to the Secretary. The costs of the sur-
- 7 vey and any administrative costs related to the land ex-
- 8 change shall be borne by the County.
- 9 (e) Condition on Use of Conveyed Land.—As
- 10 a condition of the conveyance to the County under sub-
- 11 section (a), the County shall agree to continue to use the
- 12 land acquired by the County under such subsection for
- 13 purposes consistent with the purposes listed in the special
- 14 use authorization for the Fouts Springs Ranch in effect
- 15 as of the date of the enactment of this Act.
- 16 (f) Easement Authority.—The Secretary may
- 17 grant an easement to provide continued access to, and
- 18 maintenance and use of, the facilities covered by the spe-
- 19 cial use authorization referred to in subsection (e) as nec-
- 20 essary for the continued operation of the Fouts Springs
- 21 Ranch conveyed under subsection (a).
- 22 (g) Management of Acquired Land.—The lands
- 23 acquired by the Secretary under subsection (a) shall be
- 24 added to and administered as part of the Mendocino Na-
- 25 tional Forest and managed in accordance with the Act of

- 1 March 1, 1911 (commonly known as the Weeks Act; 16
- 2 U.S.C. 480 et seq.) and the laws and regulations applica-
- 3 ble to the National Forest System.
- 4 (h) Additional Terms and Conditions.—The
- 5 land exchange under subsection (a) shall be subject to
- 6 such additional terms and conditions as the Secretary and
- 7 the County may agree upon.
- 8 (i) CANCELLATION OF PORTION OF UNOBLIGATED
- 9 BALANCE IN FLREA SPECIAL ACCOUNT.—The amount
- 10 available for obligation as of the date of the enactment
- 11 of this Act from the unobligated balance in the special ac-
- 12 count established for the Forest Service under section 807
- 13 of the Federal Lands Recreation Enhancement Act (16
- 14 U.S.C. 6806) is reduced by a total of \$60,000, and the
- 15 amount so reduced is hereby cancelled.
