SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO EXPAND DUCK STAMP DISTRIBU-

2 TION AND INCREASE PRICE. 3 Section 2 of the Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp Act (16 U.S.C. 718a et seg.), popularly 4 5 known as the "Duck Stamp Act" (16 U.S.C. 718b), is amended as follows: 6 7 (1) By amending subsection (a)(1)(B) to read 8 as follows: 9 "(B) such other official distributors as are 10 designated by the Secretary or any other estab-11 lishments, facilities, or locations as the Postal 12 Service or the Secretary (or a designee) may di-13 rect or authorize.". (2) In subsection (a)(3) by inserting "and any 14 15 official distributor designated by the Secretary" 16 after "Postal Service". 17 (3) By amending subsection (b) to read as fol-18 lows: 19 "(b) Price of Stamps.—The Postal Service and any 20 other official distributor designated by the Secretary under subsection (a)(1)(B) shall collect, for each stamp 22 sold— 23 "(1) \$25 for a stamp for any of hunting years 24 2010 through 2016; and

- 1 "(2) \$35 for a stamp for any hunting year after
- 2 hunting year 2020.".
