A BILL

To clarify the applicability of the Buy American Act to products purchased for the use of the legislative branch, to prohibit the application of any of the exceptions to the requirements of such Act to products bearing a Congressional seal, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Congressional Made
- 5 in America Promise Act of 2009".

1	SEC. 2. APPLICABILITY OF BUY AMERICAN ACT TO LEGIS-
2	LATIVE BRANCH; NO EXCEPTIONS FOR PROD-
3	UCTS BEARING CONGRESSIONAL SEAL.
4	(a) In General.—Section 2 of the Buy American
5	Act (41 U.S.C. 10a) is amended—
6	(1) by striking "Notwithstanding" and insert-
7	ing the following:
8	"(a) In General.—Notwithstanding"; and
9	(2) by adding at the end the following:
10	"(b) Clarification of Applicability to Arti-
11	CLES, MATERIALS, AND SUPPLIES FOR USE OF LEGISLA-
12	TIVE BRANCH.—
13	"(1) Applicability to legislative
14	BRANCH.—Except as provided in paragraph (2),
15	subsection (a) applies with respect to articles, mate-
16	rials, and supplies acquired for the use of any office
17	in the legislative branch, including the House of
18	Representatives and the Senate, in the same manner
19	as such subsection applies with respect to articles,
20	materials, and supplies acquired for the use of a de-
21	partment or independent establishment.
22	"(2) Special rule for products bearing
23	CONGRESSIONAL SEAL.—In the case of any product
24	which bears the seal of the United States House of
25	Representatives, the seal of the United States Sen-
26	ate, or the seal of the United States Congress and

1	which is acquired for the use of an office of the leg-
2	islative branch, the following shall apply:
3	"(A) The head of the office may not make
4	a determination under subsection (a) that it is
5	inconsistent with the public interest to enter
6	into a contract in accordance with this Act.
7	"(B) The head of the office may not make
8	a determination under subsection (a) that an
9	article, material, or supply is not mined, pro-
10	duced, or manufactured, as the case may be, in
11	the United States in sufficient and reasonably
12	available commercial quantities and of satisfac-
13	tory quality.
14	"(C) The last sentence of subsection (a)
15	shall not apply.".
16	(b) Conforming Amendment.—Section 69 of the
17	Revised Statutes of the United States (2 U.S.C. 109) is
18	repealed.
19	SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.
20	The amendments made by this Act shall take effect
21	upon the expiration of the 180-day period which begins
