3	(a) In General.—Section 1834(a)(5) of the Social

6	(F)" and inserting "and (E)"; and
7	(2) by striking subparagraph (F).
8	(b) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
9	subsection (a) shall take effect as of the date of the enact-
10	ment of this Act, and shall apply to individuals receiving
11	oxygen equipment before, on, or after December 31, 2005.

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
