A BILL

To require the Federal Government to use purchases of goods or services through the Federal supply schedules for the purpose of meeting certain contracting goals for participation by small business concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. USE OF FEDERAL SUPPLY SCHEDULES BY FED-**
2 **ERAL GOVERNMENT TO MEET CONTRACTING**
3 **GOALS FOR PARTICIPATION BY SMALL BUSI-**
4 **NESS CONCERNS OWNED AND CONTROLLED**
5 **BY SERVICE-DISABLED VETERANS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Office of Federal Procure-
7 ment Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 401 et seq.) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following new section:

9 **“SEC. 45. FEDERAL SUPPLY SCHEDULES.**

10 “Notwithstanding any law or regulation relating to
11 the Federal supply schedules of the General Services Ad-
12 ministration, a contracting officer of an executive agency
13 shall use purchases of goods or services through the Fed-
14 eral supply schedules for a fiscal year for the purpose of
15 meeting the Government-wide goal for that fiscal year
16 under section 15(g)(1) of the Small Business Act (15
17 U.S.C. 644(g)(1)) for participation by small business con-
18 cerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans.”.

19 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
20 in section 1(b) of such Act is amended by adding at the
21 end the following new item:

“45. Federal supply schedules.”.
