6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Office of Federal Procure7 ment Policy Act (41 U.S.C. 401 et seq.) is amended by
8 adding at the end the following new section:

### 9 "SEC. 45. FEDERAL SUPPLY SCHEDULES.

10 "Notwithstanding any law or regulation relating to the Federal supply schedules of the General Services Ad-11 ministration, a contracting officer of an executive agency 12 shall use purchases of goods or services through the Fed-13 eral supply schedules for a fiscal year for the purpose of 14 meeting the Government-wide goal for that fiscal year 15 under section 15(g)(1) of the Small Business Act (15) 16 17 U.S.C. 644(g)(1) for participation by small business concerns owned and controlled by service-disabled veterans.". 18 19 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections 20 in section 1(b) of such Act is amended by adding at the
