3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Training5 Act".

1SEC. 2. APPROVAL OF CERTAIN EDUCATIONAL INSTITU-2TIONS FOR PURPOSES OF THE POST-9/11 EDU-3CATIONAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

4 Subsection (b) of section 3313 of title 38, United5 States Code, is amended to read as follows:

6 "(b) APPROVED PROGRAMS OF EDUCATION.—A pro-7 gram of education is an approved program of education 8 for purposes of this chapter if the program of education 9 is approved for purposes of chapter 30 of this title (includ-10 ing approval by the State approving agency concerned) 11 and—

12 "(1) the program of education is offered by an 13 institution offering postsecondary level academic in-14 struction that leads to an associate or higher degree 15 and such institution is an institution of higher learn-16 ing (as that term is defined in section 3452(f) of 17 this title); or

18 "(2) the program of education offered by an in-19 stitution offering instruction that does not lead to an 20 associate or higher degree and such institution is an 21 educational institution (as that term is defined in 22 section 3452(c) of this title).".
