A BILL

To require mobile phones containing digital cameras to make a sound when a photograph is taken.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Camera Phone Pred-
- 5 ator Alert Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. FINDING.
- 7 Congress finds that children and adolescents have
- 8 been exploited by photographs taken in dressing rooms
- 9 and public places with the use of a camera phone.

1 SEC. 3. AUDIBLE SOUND STANDARD.

- 2 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Beginning 1 year after the date
- 3 of enactment of this Act, any mobile phone containing a
- 4 digital camera that is manufactured for sale in the United
- 5 States shall sound a tone or other sound audible within
- 6 a reasonable radius of the phone whenever a photograph
- 7 is taken with the camera in such phone. A mobile phone
- 8 manufactured after such date shall not be equipped with
- 9 a means of disabling or silencing such tone or sound.
- 10 (b) Enforcement by Consumer Product Safety
- 11 Commission.—The requirement in subsection (a) shall be
- 12 treated as a consumer product safety standard promul-
- 13 gated by the Consumer Product Safety Commission under
- 14 section 7 of the Consumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C.
- 15 2056). A violation of subsection (a) shall be enforced by
- 16 the Commission under section 19 of such Act (15 U.S.C.
- 17 2068).
