# A BILL

To provide a statutory waiver of compliance with the Jones Act to foreign-flagged vessels assisting in responding to the Deepwater Horizon oil spill, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Water Assistance from
- 5 International Vessels for Emergency Response Act" or the
- 6 "WAIVER Act".

### 1 SEC. 2. WAIVERS.

- 2 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, section
- 3 12112 and chapter 551 of title 46, United States Code,
- 4 shall not apply to any vessel documented under the laws
- 5 of a foreign country while that vessel is engaged in con-
- 6 tainment, remediation, or associated activities in the Gulf
- 7 of Mexico in connection with the mobile offshore drilling
- 8 unit Deepwater Horizon oil spill.
