To amend certain provisions of the Natural Gas Act relating to exportation or importation of natural gas, and for other purposes.

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Local Control for En-
- 5 ergy and Environment Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. EXPORTATION OR IMPORTATION OF NATURAL GAS.
- 7 (a) Amendments to Natural Gas Act.—
- 8 (1) Scope of Natural Gas act.—Section 1(b)
- 9 of the Natural Gas Act (15 U.S.C. 717(b)) is
- amended by striking "and to the importation or ex-

3 SEC. 3. CONSULTATION WITH STATES AND AVAILABILITY.

- 4 (a) FERC Consultation With States.—Notwith-
- 5 standing any other provision of law, any interagency
- 6 agreements, collaborations, or activities regarding the en-
- 7 vironmental impact, safety to public, or security of a lique-
- 8 fied natural gas facility entered into by the Federal En-
- 9 ergy Regulatory Commission shall, where appropriate, in-
- 10 clude input by and consultation with the State in which
- 11 such facility is located.
- 12 (b) AVAILABILITY.—Notwithstanding any other pro-
- 13 vision of law, agreements, collaborations, and activities de-
- 14 scribed in subsection (a), and the subsequent reports and
- 15 documents from such agreements, collaborations, and ac-
- 16 tivities, shall, unless vital to national security, as deter-
- 17 mined by the Secretary of Homeland Security, be made
- 18 available to the public in print and on an Internet website.

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
