In lieu of the amendment rec-2 ommended by the Committee on Energy and Commerce 3 now printed in the bill, an amendment in the nature of 4 a substitute consisting of the text of H.R. 2998, modified by the amendment printed in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution, shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be 8 considered as read. All points of order against provisions of the bill, as amended, are waived. The previous question 10 shall be considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto, to final passage 11 12 without intervening motion except: (1) three hours of debate, with two and one half hours equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the 14 15 Committee on Energy and Commerce and 30 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking 16 minority member of the Committee on Ways and Means; 18 (2) the further amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in part B of the report of the Committee on Rules, 19 if offered by Representative Forbes of Virginia or his des-

ignee, which shall be in order without intervention of any

point of order except those arising under clause 9 or 10

of rule XXI, shall be considered as read, and shall be sepa-

rately debatable for 30 minutes equally divided and con-
