RESOLUTION

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (S.
3 181) to amend title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964
4 and the Age Discrimination in Employment Act of 1967,
5 and to modify the operation of the Americans with Dis-
6 abilities Act of 1990 and the Rehabilitation Act of 1973,
7 to clarify that a discriminatory compensation decision or
8 other practice that is unlawful under such Acts occurs
9 each time compensation is paid pursuant to the discrimi-
10 natory compensation decision or other practice, and for
11 other purposes. All points of order against consideration
12 of the bill are waived except those arising under clause
13 10 of rule XXI. The bill shall be considered as read. All
14 points of order against the bill are waived. The previous
15 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill to final
16 passage without intervening motion except: (1) one hour
17 of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and
18 ranking minority member of the Committee on Education
19 and Labor; and (2) one motion to commit.
