A BILL

To reauthorize the Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Federal Land Trans-
5 action Facilitation Act Reauthorization of 2009”.

6 **SEC. 2. FEDERAL LAND TRANSACTION FACILITATION ACT.**

7 The Federal Land Transaction Facilitation Act is
8 amended—

1 (1) in section 203(2) (43 U.S.C. 2302(2)), by
2 striking “on the date of enactment of this Act was”
3 and inserting “is”;

4 (2) in section 205 (43 U.S.C. 2304)—

5 (A) in subsection (a), by striking “this
6 Act” and inserting “the Federal Land Trans-
7 action Facilitation Act Reauthorization of
8 2009”; and

9 (B) by striking subsection (d);

10 (3) in section 206 (43 U.S.C. 2305), by striking
11 subsection (f); and

12 (4) in section 207(b) (43 U.S.C. 2306(b))—

13 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “; or”
14 and inserting a semicolon;

15 (B) in paragraph (2)—

16 (i) by inserting “Public Law 105–
17 263;” before “112 Stat.”; and

18 (ii) by striking the period at the end
19 and inserting a semicolon; and

20 (C) by adding at the end the following:

21 “(3) the White Pine County Conservation,
22 Recreation, and Development Act of 2006 (Public
23 Law 109–432; 120 Stat. 3028); or

1 “(4) the Lincoln County Conservation, Recre-
2 ation, and Development Act of 2004 (Public Law
3 108–424; 118 Stat. 2403).”.
