3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Federal Supply Sched-
- 5 ules Usage Act of 2009".

SEC. 2. AUTHORITY OF THE AMERICAN RED CROSS TO USE FEDERAL SUPPLY SCHEDULES FOR CERTAIN GOODS AND SERVICES.

4 Section 502 of title 40, United States Code, is 5 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-6 section:

7 "(e) Use of Supply Schedules by the Red 8 Cross.—

9 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator may 10 provide for the use by the American National Red 11 Cross of Federal supply schedules. Purchases under 12 this authority shall be used in furtherance of the 13 purposes of the American National Red Cross set 14 forth in section 300102 of title 36, United States 15 Code.

16 "(2) LIMITATION.—The authority under this
17 subsection may not be used to purchase supplies for
18 resale.".

19 SEC. 3. DUTY OF USERS REGARDING USE OF FEDERAL SUP20 PLY SCHEDULES.

21 Section 502 of title 40, United States Code, as
22 amended by section 2, is further amended by adding at
23 the end the following new subsection:

24 "(f) DUTY OF USERS REGARDING USE OF SUPPLY
25 SCHEDULES.—All users of Federal supply schedules, in26 cluding non-Federal users, shall use the schedules in ac•S 2868 RS

cordance with the ordering guidance provided by the Ad ministrator of General Services.".

3 SEC. 4. AUTHORITY OF STATE AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS 4 TO USE SUPPLY SCHEDULES FOR CERTAIN 5 GOODS AND SERVICES.
