12	"(a) In General.—The Archivist of the United				
13	States, after considering the advice and recommendations				
14	of the National Historical Publications and Records Com-				
15	mission, may make grants to States, colleges and univer-				
16	sities, museums, libraries, and genealogical associations to				
17	preserve records and establish electronically searchable				
18	databases consisting of local records of servitude, emanci-				
19	pation, and post-Civil War reconstruction.				
20	"(b) Maintenance.—Any database established				
21	using a grant under this section shall be maintained by
