To increase the limits on liability under the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Outer Continental

5 Shelf Lands Act Amendments Act of 2010".

6 SEC. 2. REMEDIES AND PENALTIES UNDER THE OUTER
7 CONTINENTAL SHELF LANDS ACT.

8 (a) CIVIL PENALTIES.—Section 24(b) of the Outer
9 Continental Shelf Lands Act (43 U.S.C. 1350(b)) is
10 amended—

1 (1) in the first sentence of paragraph (1), by 2 striking "\$20,000" and inserting "\$75,000"; and 3 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking "may be as-4 sessed" and inserting "of not more than \$150,000 5 for each day of the continuance of the failure shall 6 be assessed"; and 7 (b) CRIMINAL PENALTIES.—The first sentence of section 24(c) of the Outer Continental Shelf Lands Act 8 (43 U.S.C. 1350(c)) is amended by striking "\$100,000" 9 and inserting "\$10,000,000". 10 (c) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by 11

12 subsection (a) take effect on April 15, 2010.
