(1) by striking "January 1, 2017" in paragraph
(1) and inserting "January 1, 2014", and
(2) by inserting "beginning not later than 180
days after the date of the enactment of the Empow ering States to Innovate Act" after "application" in
paragraph (4)(B)(ii).

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
